

Extended Learning Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How would an Extended Learning Day look for my child?

A: If/when classes are canceled due to an event, families will receive an email from their building principal and/or their child's teacher that would provide instructions on classwork/projects/activities to be completed during this timeframe. This information will also be made available on the District's website.

Q: Is my child expected to be on the student device all day to complete work?

A: No. While there might be some classwork to be completed on the student device, much of the day will incorporate learning activities that will NOT require use of the student devices.

Q: What if my child does not have access to the internet at home?

A: If your child does not have internet access at home, you are encouraged to contact the building Principal at 660-748-3211 so that accommodations can be made. To reiterate what was stated above, only a portion of the work on these days would need to be completed on the student device.

Q: Who should I contact if I have questions about the Extended Learning assignments?

A: Questions should be directed to the classroom teacher(s). In addition, students and parents may also contact building principals if needed. Our staff will be posting their available office hours where students and parents will be able communicate.

Q: How will my child receive their assignments for the Extended Learning Day?

A: Students at both the Pre-School and elementary schools will receive information from their teachers. Students in grades 7-12 will receive information from their teachers and academic advisors through the google classroom, phone calls, and e-mail.

Q: Will my child receive a grade for Extended Learning assignments?

A: Yes, students will be required to complete all assignments. While the school building is closed we are still providing education.

Q: How will I return my child's completed assignments?

A: Students can return their completed assignments in many different formats. Your teacher will communicate directly with you to allow the best option for each student.
