## **Princeton Tax Rate Hearing**

The board approved the proposed tax rate as presented to the Board of Education for the 2021-22 School Year. Incidental rate would be \$4.0425, Debt Service rate would be \$0.9532, and Capital Projects rate of .1800 for a total tax rate of \$5.1757 per \$100 assessed value.
