# The consent agenda was approved consisting of Call Meeting to Order

#### **Old Business**

- The Board of Education approved bank depository services with First Interstate Bank of Princeton, MO.
- Princeton Ball Association, The City of Princeton, & The Princeton R-V School District are working together to relocate the ball fields. Site work began last week on the three-field project. Bid opening for materials will be June 23<sup>rd</sup> at City Hall.
- The Board of Education approved a Cooperative agreement with the Newtown Harris school district for football. Newtown students grades 7-12 will now be eligible to play football at Princeton.

#### **New Business**

- The Board of Education was updated on a possible grant to increase teacher's minimum salary and career ladder. A Budget Item approved by the Senate and the House will allow districts to apply for a grant from the state to increase the minimum teacher salary to \$38,000 but the request is voluntary, it will require a local match, and state funds are not guaranteed after next year. The district will be waiting on guidance from DESE to see how the Grant will affect the district's finances. The Governor will need to sign the legislation before grant funding will be available.
- The board approved the fuel bid for 22-23 school year. MFA was the only bidder with .02 off posted pump price.
