New Business

A) Athletics & Activities Program Review: The Board of Education was presented information from Athletic Director, Scott Ussery and Coach Nathan Powell regarding Princeton's current conference affiliation. The information showed the downward trend of student enrollment at Princeton R-V. The district is evaluating a possibility of applying to participate in the West Division of the Grand River Conference. This move will also potentially lead to Princeton moving to an 8-Man Football Program. The presentation focused on the desire for Princeton athletic programs to compete with similar sized schools for a conference schedule. The district will host an information night on January 17th. In addition, the board of education will have public comments available at their next two regularly scheduled board meetings in February and March. It is anticipated that the board of education will vote on the proposal at the March 14th meeting.

Covid-19 Employee Leave Resolution - Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA), which provided two weeks, or up to 80 hours of Emergency Paid Sick Leave (EPSL) for qualifying reasons related to COVID-19 has been extended for the 21-22 School Year at Princeton R-V. Employers are no longer required to provide paid time off to employees for any of the COVID related reasons under EPSL or the Expanded Family Medical Leave Act. The Princeton R-V School Board approved a resolution to extend COVID-19 leave through June of 2022. The approved resolution supports the extension of paid leave (District EPSL) for all employees instructed not to report for work and who did not exhaust the former EPSL leave. "While we hope our staff does not have to use the leave time provided with the resolution, we hope that it provides peace of mind to our staff that the days will be there if needed."
